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University Preparation at Nusa Alam Using Unifrog

At Nusa Alam, we are committed to supporting students on their journey beyond secondary school, whether they aim to attend university, pursue vocational training, or explore alternative pathways. One of the key tools we use to guide this process is Unifrog, a comprehensive online platform that helps students make well-informed decisions about their futures.

What is Unifrog?

Unifrog is a powerful online platform that supports students in exploring their interests, researching university and career options, and building competitive applications. It is used by leading international schools around the world and is especially effective in helping students find the best-fit opportunities based on their skills, goals, and academic profiles.

At Nusa Alam, students begin using Unifrog from **Year 7 through to Year 12**, ensuring they are familiar with its tools and confident in making decisions by the time they reach their final years of study.

How Unifrog Supports University Preparation

1. Career and Interest Exploration

Unifrog helps students identify their strengths and passions through interactive quizzes and reflective tools. These guide them toward future careers, university programs, and subjects that align with their personal interests.

2. Global University and Course Search

Students can search and compare universities and programs from around the world, including the UK, US, Australia, Canada, Asia and Europe. They can filter options based on entry requirements, tuition fees, subjects, and other key factors.





3. Application Planning and Guidance

- **Personal Statement Builder:** Offers a structured approach to writing strong, effective personal statements
- **UCAS and Common App Support:** For UK and US applications, students can track and manage their university applications directly through the platform
- **Scholarship and Alternative Pathways:** Students also have access to information about scholarships, apprenticeships, and vocational routes

4. One-on-One Student Support

Nusa Alam provides individual university guidance sessions with students to ensure they receive personalized support throughout their application process. These one-on-one meetings are designed to help students stay organized, meet deadlines, and receive detailed feedback on their choices and application materials.

5. Teacher and Counselor Collaboration

Pak Peter, Head of Unifrog at Nusa Alam, works closely with teachers and counselors to ensure students are using the platform effectively. Our staff can review students' plans, comment on application drafts, and support them through each stage of their journey.

6. Skill Building and Activity Tracking

Students can log their extracurriculars, achievements, and leadership experiences in real time. This running record becomes very useful when applying for university or building a CV.

7. Parental Involvement

We believe parents play an essential role in the university planning process. Parent access to Unifrog is currently being set up, and we will be inviting families to view their child's progress and explore available resources in the near future.

Year 7 – Introduction and Discovery

Focus: Build comfort with the platform, explore personal identity, and begin career curiosity

Quarter Goals

- T1** Introduction to Unifrog platform. Students log in, set up profiles, and learn how the platform works.
- T2** Complete the Personality Profile. Begin the Skills Profile and reflect on areas of strength.
- T3** Explore the Careers Library. Watch videos and save interesting jobs. Add reflections.
- T4** Log one personal achievement in the Activities section. Discuss what skills were used.





Year 8 – Strengths and Aspirations

Focus: Deepen self-awareness and link interests to possible futures

Quarter Goals

- T1 Revisit and update the Skills Profile. Add examples from class or extracurriculars.
- T2 Complete or revisit the Interests Profile. Connect these interests to jobs or careers.
- T3 Use the Subjects Library to explore how school subjects link to career paths.
- T4 Create a first draft of a basic CV using experiences logged in Unifrog.

Year 9 – Pathway Awareness

Focus: Make meaningful subject choices and understand future academic and career paths

Quarter Goals

- T1 Use the IGCSE Subject Guide to inform IGCSE choices. Explore university courses that relate to subjects.
- T2 Begin a Careers Shortlist. Save at least 3 interesting career options and reflect on why they appeal.
- T3 Update the Activities Record with non-academic experiences (sports, leadership, volunteering).
- T4 Review all saved career profiles and explore university entry requirements for each one.

Year 10 – Building Direction

Focus: Connect academic choices with future opportunities and begin early planning

Quarter Goals

- T1 Use the University Shortlisting Tool to explore international options. Save 3–5 potential courses.
- T2 Begin logging competencies using the Competencies Tool (e.g. communication, resilience).
- T3 Draft a second version of the CV, focusing on clarity and relevance.
- T4 Compare entry requirements for different countries (UK, US, Australia, etc.). Discuss implications for A-level choices.

Year 11 – Application Planning and Focus

Focus: Narrow down choices and begin serious application preparation

Quarter Goals

- T1 Finalise the University Shortlist. Use filters to explore course fit and entry criteria.
- T2 Begin drafting a Personal Statement or Common App essay using Unifrog's tools.
- T3 Attend a 1-on-1 guidance session. Review shortlist, goals, and application strategy.
- T4 Log any academic awards, projects, internships, or service learning. Refine CV accordingly.



Year 12 – Application and Transition

Focus: Submit applications, manage offers, and prepare for the next stage

Quarter Goals

- T1** Finalise and submit UCAS / Common App or other university applications. Upload essays and personal statements.
- T2** Track application progress using Unifrog’s Application Tracker. Begin researching scholarships and financial aid.
- T3** Log university offers and responses. Begin reviewing university transition resources on Unifrog.
- T4** Confirm final destination. Reflect on the journey. Log a graduate profile for future Nusa Alam students.
